FOREIGN CROPS IN POOR CONDITION

Drought in India Occasions Much Alarm—Weather Unseasonable in Europe.

Broomhall's weekly summary of foreign crop conditions, issued yesterday in Liverpool, is as follows: There are complaints of loss of color to the plant, with the land saturated with moisture. The weather is unseasonably wet.

France.—Complaints increasing, especially in the northern regions, where the plant is losing color and weeds are prevalent. Offerings of native wheat are on a more liberal scale, with the market easier. The weather is unseasonable.

Germany.—There is some snow, but there are wide areas where the snow is melting. The weather is unseasonably wet.

Russia.—There are complaints of inadequate snow cover. Reports regarding the reserves in the interior are conflicting, but it is generally agreed that the crops were officially overestimated. The weather is cold.

Roumania.—Crop conditions are normal. Arrivals small, with the weather unseasonable. The market is easier.

Hungary.—Crop conditions are satisfactory. The weather is unseasonably wet. The market is easier.
