

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL B¹⁶.

An Act for the relief of Margaret Francis Kennedy Bailie.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Margaret Francis Kennedy Bailie, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of Robert James Bailie, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the town of Hampstead, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the eighth day of June, A.D. 1938, at the city of Belfast, Northern Ireland, she then being Margaret Francis Kennedy, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage between Margaret Francis Kennedy and Robert James Bailie, her husband, is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to marry again.

2. The said Margaret Francis Kennedy may at any time hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry if the said marriage with the said Robert James Bailie had not been solemnized.
