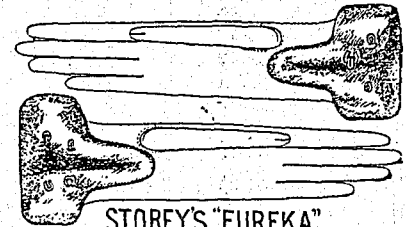

LECAN, Ont., has voted a bonus of \$10,000 for
a branch railway to Brecon.

AMONG other improvements talked of, Sar-
nia, Ont., is to have a ship-yard, the electric
light, and a new drainage.

THE GRANGERS in different sections of Ontario
are winding up their business operations,
having found the speculation a bad one.

LARGE GANGS of men are actively engaged in
Western Ontario forests, getting out timber
destined for the Quebec market.

DURING the past fiscal year there has been an
increase of \$1,800,000 in the Post-Office Savings
Bank deposits of the Dominion.

A RESIDENT of Gorrie, Ont., asks a bonus of
\$3,000 to enable him to sink a salt well in
that village, promising to return the amount in
the event of his procuring brine.

THE value of the exports, principally of lum-
ber and barley, from the Belleville Consular
District during the past year, was \$1,382,014.-
