it, the Reformed Church joined, and the United Presbyterian Church co-operated. One of the best contributions the last-named made to the cause was the gift of their missionary, Dr. Laws, whose name as n issionary, administrator, and teacher, shines with a lustre throughout Central Africa, only eclipsed by that of the man whose spirit he perpetuated. Livingstone dead, in all those tributes of mission and church, continues to live; and, as we think about him again, will live more than ever.
