Section 6.—The Sheriff shall, immediately upon receipt of his copies, cause one of them to be posted up in a conspicuous place in the Court House; the Clerk of the Peace, upon receipt of his copies, shall cause one of them to be posted up in a conspicuous place in his office; every Public or Separate School Head Master or Mistress, shall in like manner post up one of his or her copies on the door of the School-house, and every Postmaster shall post up one of his copies in the Post-office—Chap. 9, R. S. O., 39 Vic., Chap. 11, Sec. 2.
