any subsequent meeting, the Secretary shall announce that the said member is liable to expulsion, and such announcement shall be recorded in the minutes, together with the fact that the member is still indebted to the Society in the sum of three dollars or more.

- (c). The presiding officer shall thereupon declare the member suspended from membership and the member shall stand suspended from membership.
- 5. A suspended member desiring to be reinstated shall make a written application, which shall then be acted upon as in the case of a new application, after payment of all demands against him, he may, upon the report of the Investigating Committee, be reinstated by a two-third vote of all members present and voting, which voting shall be taken by ballot.
- 6. Members suspended for non-payment of dues shall not be liable for dues, fines or assessments during their suspension.

ARTICLE VIII.

RESIGNATIONS.

A member may resign upon paying all demands against him. His resignation must be in writing.

ARTICLE IX.

AMENDMENTS.

The Society shall at all times have power to add to, amend or alter and rescind these by-laws at any regular meeting on a two-third majority of votes of
