

The Formal Opening

Friday, February the 21st. was a red letter day to be thankfully remembered in the history of the College. Nearly one thousand persons were present on the occasion of the Opening of the New Wing.

The evening began with a Meeting in the Convocation Hall, which was opened by the singing of the Doxology and the offering of special thanksgiving by the Right Reverend Dr. Reeve, Assistant Bishop of Toronto.

It was fitting that on this historic occasion the name of the late Principal Sheraton should be prominently in the minds of the friends of the College. In his honoured memory were presented by the students three beautifully carved oak Convocation Chairs, and by the Graduates a very finely executed oil painting of Dr. Sheraton. The presentation of the former was made by the Rev. L. E. Davis, M.A., one of the present students, and the portrait was unveiled by the Rev. L. E. Skey, M.A., Rector of St. Anne's Church, Toronto, as representing his fellow Graduates. These appropriate gifts were accepted on behalf of the College by the President, Dr. N. W. Hoyles, K.C., and the Rev. Principal O'Meara.
