

The water will be delivered 180 feet above the point where the operations will take place, thus affording a good pressure. From this point the water is conducted to the mine by a pipe 18 inches diameter to which are connected four monitors of two and one-half and three-inch nozzle.

The area of dumping ground is practically unlimited, as there is the whole creek to dump and the end of the sluice boxes to the bottom of the creek is 90 feet along a steep hillside.

The sluices are provided with block riffles and are 500 feet long, with a grade of eight per cent.

As the company has just completed the installation of this plant and is about to start hydraulic mining, no cleanup has been made as yet, and no data can be given as to the quality of the gravel to be produced, as to the cost of operation and the duty of a miner's inch.
