

PINKOLA BEATS CRACKS IN \$15,000 HANDICAP

Pinkola Was an Added Starter—Frank Gill Was Second and King James Third.

NEW YORK, Aug. 22.—Pinkola, an added starter, ridden by J. Butler, won the \$15,000 Empire City Handicap, 1 1/2 miles, at Empire City today, defeating a fine field of handicap horses. Pinkola ran and won yesterday and made a new track record for the distance and his victory today stamps him as a high-class colt. Frank Gill was second and King James third. Pinkola ran with a wonderful burst of speed, outran King James in the run down the back stretch and was leading by one length at the far turn, but here Pinkola began to move up and at the turn into the stretch Pinkola showed in front by a head. It was now a terrific drive and Pinkola, standing it gamely, won by one and a half lengths. Frank Gill beat King James a length for the place.
