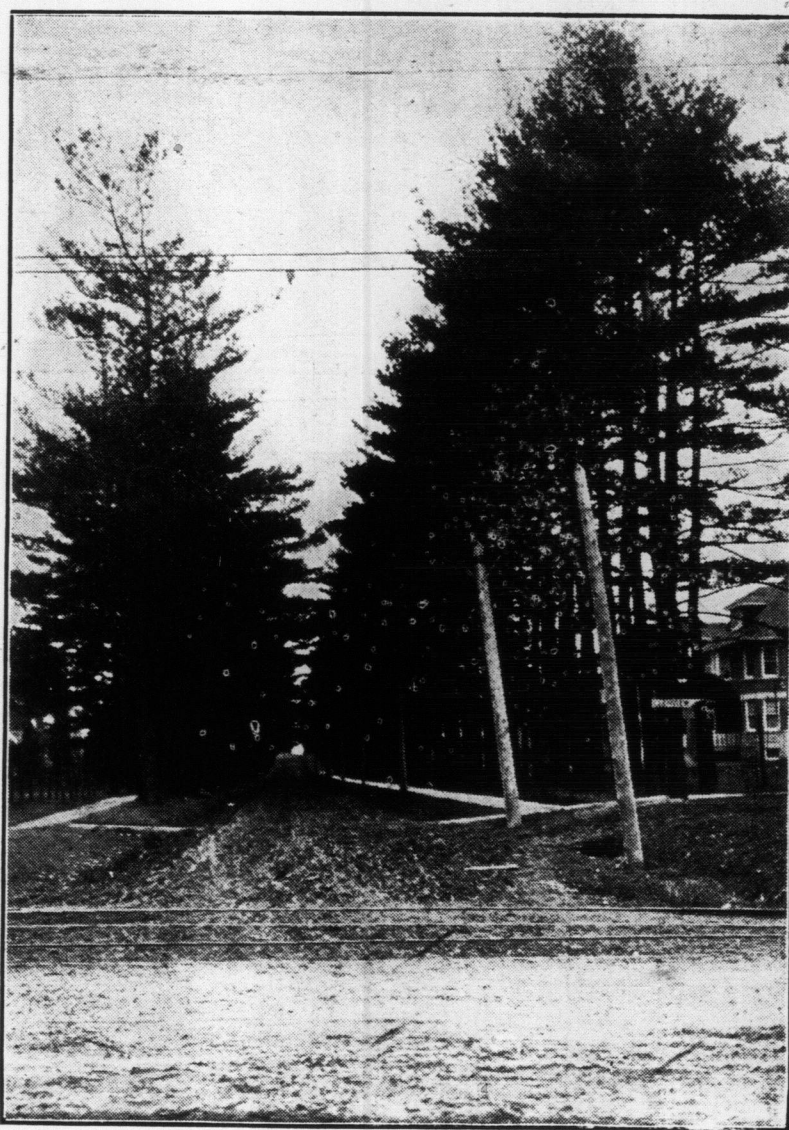
**TRUE TO NATURE STORY**

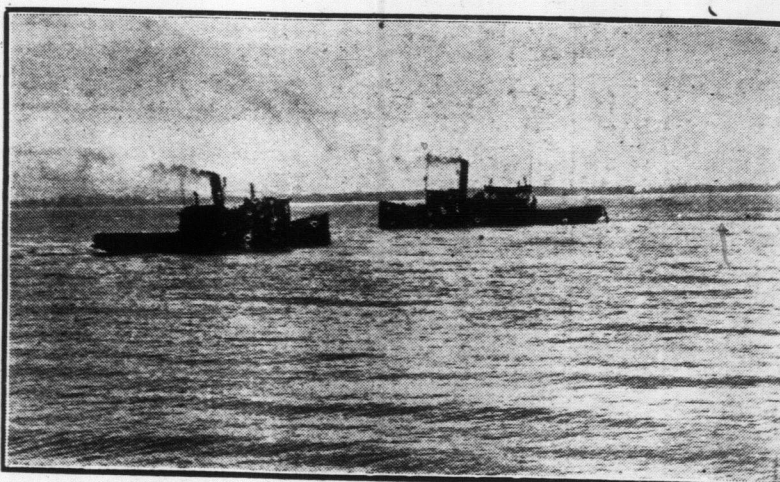
