The total number of patients attended during the past year was 73,820. Average cost of each patient twelve cents. All who desire to obtain better personal knowledge of the necessity for such institutions, their practical benefit to the sick poor, and their claims on the liberality of our citizens, are invited to visit the Dispensary during the Physicians visiting hours on any day (except Sunday), and judge for themselves.

This institution furnishes medical and surgical aid and medicines to the sick poor of every nationality and religion in Montreal.

The attending physicians visit at their own homes those who are unable to come to the Dispensary and too poor to pay.

In restoring to health, it restores to many their only means of support, and thus prevents poverty, pauperism and crime.

It is dependent, chiefly, upon voluntary contributions for its support.
