

Rubber being scarce in Germany n wadays, a number of bicycle tires made of substitutes for rubber are reported to have appeared on the German market, says the June Popular Mechanics Magazine. First came a tire made of steel wire 3-16 in. thick, closely coiled, with ends welded together. This was with ends welded together. A Lecture on German Liberty

Herr Professors Abuse President Wilson and Vaunt Ideals of Their Fatherland

Berlin, May 23.—Last night the first of a series of lectures on "Germany and America" was given in the grand hall of the Prussian Diet building. "German Liberty" was the subject exploited by Dr. Freiderich Meinecke, but Professor Poeter von Harnack preceded it fessor Doctor von Harnack preceded it with some very sarcastic remarks on "Wilson's American ideal of liberty." This pacifistic, democratic and plutocratic ideal in a universal uniform, in which they wanted Germany to masquerade, said Harnack, represented the sharpest contrast to the nature of Germany's interior and exterior liberty.

But one point must be kept steadily in view. America conducted a silent war against us long before the declaration of war, and never was particular in choosing her means. Wilson and many Americans with him have undergone an ugly development from honest democratic-republicanism to bedisened emperorism. In addition, Wilson distinguishes himself by his amazing ignorance about Germany. He is an intellectual moralist, but without any depth whatever."

Harnack then quoted extensively from Woodrow Wilson's book to show "what a startling political, judicial, ethical mentanophosis the president had passed through in changing his convictions like his trousers. 
