Boston Born, Living in Yonkers, Became Austrian by Marriage; Now He's American, She's Alien.

Many puzzles come before Ira Hoyt, chief of the local passport bureau, as Senators, citizens, aliens and other kinds of people try to make arrangements for a trip to Europe. A case that came up this week, however, was a super-puzzle, a veritable labyrinth of law and acute intelligence.




