Unfair Competition Charges Are Denied by Procter & Gamble in Cincinnati Hearing.
Cincinnati, Oct. 11.—Hearings have been held on the complaint filed in 1922 by the Federal Trade Commission against the Procter & Gamble Company on the ground that one of its widely marketed brands of soap was advertised and sold in violation of Section 5 of the trade commission act, making it unlawful to engage in unfair competition.
Hearings were held in New York early in June of this year, at which witnesses for the government produced testimony in support of the complaint. Testimony is being offered here by the Procter & Gamble Company in defense. The Federal Trade Commission having in July denied a motion to dis-
