Dr. Tausig Tells Medical Association Convention of New Treatment.

Rowboat Trip Over Atlantic Is Recalled

By a New Venture

Three Men Shortly to Start From Hamburg to U. S. in 45-Foot Yacht; Two Rowed Across in 62 Days.

London, June 6.—(By mail.)—Captain Joseph Elmie, lately of the Austrian Navy, accompanied by a couple of friends, will shortly leave Hamburg for America in a forty-five-foot yacht, which they themselves have built on Lake Constance, according to Bassett Digby, writing in The London Daily Express.

"Quite a number of little yachts have crossed successfully to and from England and America by now, but we shall probably have to wait for many a long day before any sportsmen attempt to emulate the amazing feat of the two Norwegian sailors who, just twenty-seven years ago, rowed across the Atlantic in a little open boat—for the fun of the thing," he continues.
