SCOTLAND'S BATTLE (Toronto Globe).
Scottish temperance reformers have succeeded in bringing their cause to a test of public opinion in virtually every one of the 1,000 voting areas in which retail facilities for drinking are provided. For a vote to be taken is necessary that the requisition should be signed by not less than one-tenth of the electors in the district. The principle underlying the Act is usually spoken of as local veto, but it is essentially that of local veto. A local veto has no power to vote for the improvement or extension of facilities for the sale and consumption of alcohol refreshment. Three courses are open to the electors. They may vote for "no change," "limitation of licenses" or "no license." A resolution in favor of limitation can be carried by a bare majority of the electors voting. If that majority represents a minimum of 35 per cent of the voters on the register. A "no license" resolution can be carried only on condition that 55 per cent of those voting are in favor of it, and that the majority includes at least 35 per cent of the total electorate.

Even the result most favorable to the temperance workers would be far from prohibition. It would abolish the retail sale of liquor over the bars and in grocery stores, a great gain in view of the number of these licensed premises, liquor habit and an outpost for the brewers and distillers, who are fighting an attempt at restriction as they did on this continent until an outraged public sentiment overwhelmed them. But a "no license" victory in Scotland would still leave it legal to purchase and sell liquor for consumption in private houses or in clubs, while at the discretion of the licensing authority bona fide hotels and inns would be permitted to supply
