FIGHTING CORPS FOR MILITANTS

Sir Francis Vane, Boer War Veteran, Undertakes To Lead Band

SILVIA WINS AGAIN

Clever Ruse Enables Troublesome Suffragette to Elude Police and Speak at Public Meeting—Says Plan to Guard Women in the Crusade is on Ulster Model

London, Nov. 5.—By a clever stratagem which completely hoodwinked the force of police sent to prevent her from speaking, Miss Sylvia Fankhurst was enabled to announce at the Bow Baths in the East End of London, tonight, the formation of a corps, organized under the command of Captain Sir Francis Vane, a Boer war veteran, for the protection of militant suffragettes and labor unionists.

Miss Zella Emerson, of Jackson (Mich.), presided over the meeting. Just as the meeting was called to order the statement was made that the residence of George Lansbury, former Socialist member of parliament, and a warm supporter of the militant suffragettes, was surrounded by police. The crowd rushed from the Baths and found a large number of foot and mounted police.

Mr. Lansbury arrived on the scene and was uproariously greeted as he entered his home. The report was spread that the preparations pertained the arrest of Sylvia Fankhurst.

The lights in the house were extinguished and suddenly a woman rushed from the doorway and sprang into the taxi, which, surrounded by mounted police, proceeded to Bethnal Green. Then Miss Daisy Lansbury, daughter of the ex-Socialist member, stepped out, much to the discomfiture of the police.

Meanwhile, Miss Fankhurst entered the hall, which, surrounded by mounted police, proceeded to Bethnal Green.

Will Perfect Efforts. The only disorder was caused by an attack by the women on a few reporters whom they suspected of being detectives.

Miss Lansbury and Sir Francis Vane followed Miss Fankhurst to the platform. The Boer veteran explained that the plan was to establish a labor training corps. Having aloft a huge knotted club, Sir Francis said he was prepared to use the weapon wherever he saw women injured, and in labor disputes, or wherever the oppressed needed protection.

The general staff of the organization will be drawn from officers who had seen war, and both men and women are eligible for the ranks. Miss Fankhurst said the plan was based on the Ulster model, and she expected the same immunity from government interference as Sir Edward Carson, the Ulster leader, enjoyed.

When Miss Fankhurst left the meeting she was surrounded by a bodyguard of East Enders, and made her escape, after a lively battle with the police, who were compelled to draw their clubs.

The crowd retailed with sticks, and the result was that several of the hellebranders were injured, among them Miss Emerson, who was knocked down and bruised about the head. She, too, escaped arrest, being carried away by sympathizers.

THE DISADVANTAGES OF FAT-DWELLING IN MONTREAL. I have to dry them myself, as we haven't been able to find a practicable wiping machine."

"We sweep with a vacuum cleaner and one of the boys mops the kitchen floor with our electric mop, which I think is the only scientifically constructed mop I ever saw. It cost seven dollars."

"The bath-tub is fitted with a device which heats the water as it pours into a basin, and then falls into the tub proper."

Daily Hints For the Cook

Molasses Doughnuts. Two eggs, well beaten, 1-2 cup sugar, 1-2 cup molasses, 1 cup sour milk, 1 teaspoon soda (rounding full), 1 teaspoon cream of tartar (rounding full), mixing spoon melted butter, 1-2 teaspoon ginger, 1-2 teaspoon cinnamon. Mix as soft as can be handled without sticking. Cut in strips and twist.

Snowball Drops. Make a stiff batter of 3 beaten eggs, 2 small cups of sugar, 1 pint of sweet milk, half a teaspoon each of salt and grated nutmeg, and 3 teaspoons of baking powder sifted with 5 cups of flour. Fry by spoonfuls in deep fat that has reached the blue flame heat. When nearly cold roll in powdered sugar.






