Industrial sites with railway trackage can be purchased or leased at low figures. The City Hydro-Electric Plant supplies power at less than one cent per Kwt. and heat at less than two cents per Kwt. There is available for development some 200,000 horsepower.



MINERAL AND TIMBER RESOURCES

There are many mining properties with timber and water power in the Revelstoke District on which amounts varying from \$10,000.00 to \$100,000.00 have been spent in development work, several of which are now under option or being developed. The principal minerals are placer, gold, silver, lead, zinc, copper, serpentine asbestos, and mica of which there are vast bodies still awaiting development. The Government is yearly adding to the roads leading to the mineral and timber areas. The timber resources north of Revelstoke consist of virgin forest of which thirty billion feet, principally red cedar, pine, fir, spruce, hemlock and cottonwood, are marketable.



FARM LANDS

There are 125,000 acres of good farm lands in this district open for pre-emption, close to road, rail or water transportation. About 7,500 acres are cultivated, producing excellent crops of vegetables, grains and fruits. Small fruits, including strawberries, yield exceptionally large crops, and being close to the Prairie are assured of a ready market.
