very operation of grinding-by the heat of the friction produced have destroyed the labor of many weeks. The grinding of the machinery has been done sufficiently exact; the tool on which they were shaped being turned to the required form, and covered with coarse emery and water, they were ground on it to the necessary figure, and afterwards polished by means of putty or oxide of tin, spread on pitch, as a covering to the same tool in the place of the emery. To grind a Speculum of six or eight inches in diameter was a work of too ordinary labor; and such a one used to be considered one of great size. Mr. Ramsay's Reflecting Telescope, the mirror of which is fifteen inches in diameter, with a focal distance of twenty-five feet, was, till lately, the largest in use. Sir J. Herschel's, which stands in the place of his father's large one, has a Speculum of fifteen inches in diameter and a focal distance of twenty-five feet. With the difficulties of the undertaking, and the small success of his predecessor, Lord Rosse was fully acquainted, but he set about the work with a zeal that was a presage of his triumph. It is, perhaps, unnecessary to say how fitted his Lordship is in every way to accomplish his work which requires the combination of so many qualities; talent to devise, patience to bear disappointment, perseverance, profound mathematical knowledge, mechanical skill, uninterrupted leisure from other pursuits, and yet these would not have been sufficient if a great command of money had not been added. Fortunately the world has seen them all combined, and their application to the highest branch of scientific enquiry.

The fact of the great Telescope alone having cost certainly not less than twelve thousand pounds, shows how few individuals could have successfully brought so large an instrument to a happy conclusion; and if to this be added the money expended on the Telescope with the Speculum three feet in diameter, and the various sums laid out in preparing it, we see what a splendid offering has been made to the shrine of Science by one of her most devoted admirers.

The Renewed Bombardment of Sebastopol.

The fire commenced at five a.m. on the 9th of April, and continued without intermission throughout the night and the following day. Prince Gortschakoff, whose reports have usually been more accurate than those of his predecessors) reports a loss of 833 men, which is considerable, when caused exclusively by a fire against covered batteries and fortifications. He states that the Russians have not been able to repair the damage which a bombardment must have inflicted. The allied forces were in a condition to open their fire from no less than 500 guns and mortars, the greater part of which exceeded in range the Russian batteries. In fact, the allied force brought to bear against Sebastopol an amount of artillery equal to at least five ordinary siege trains in number, and superior in calibre. These enormous pieces of ordnance have hitherto been almost exclusively used in marine attacks, armed in such a manner, against an entrenched town, and if any reliance can be placed on the opinion of Sir John Burgoyne, he is known to be impossible for the place were about to open against it. On this point, however, all speculation is now vain, for at the time at which we are writing the attack was already under way, and one of the two alternatives of success or failure.

If, however, as we hope, some decided impression has been made on the part of the defenders of the place, and the guns of the Russian have been silenced on any front, it remains to be seen what measures the allied commanders are prepared to take in order to avail themselves of such an opportunity, and to press home their advantage over the enemy. It is clear, from the language of the letters received by the last mail, that the plan of an assault was by no means abandoned, although the feasibility of that operation depended on the effect of the bombardment. The force of the British Light Division is again reported to amount to about 3,800 men, and for the first time, the gallant leader, Sir George Brown. The First Division, equally well commanded by Sir Colin Campbell, numbers 4,697 men, of whom 3,500 are effective. The Naval Brigade has uniformly maintained its strength at 1,000—equal to one battalion. The effective of the Second, Third, and Fourth Divisions of the army exceed 3,000 men each, and this force is daily augmented by the arrival of reinforcements, and the return of convalescents from the hospitals. We have therefore on the spot a force of 16,000 men, and possibly a decisive part in the contest. We know not whether it be true that Omar Pasha has been ordered to the Crimea, but it is certainly a fact that the line at Baturina is now so considerably extended that they require a large force to defend them; but, if any Turkish troops can be spared, an assault on such a place as Sebastopol, supported as they will be by the flower of the two finest armies in Europe.

It remains to be seen, also, what part is reserved for the fleets under Admiral Balaam and Sir Edmund Lyons at this decisive moment. Since these officers have assumed the chief command of their respective squadrons we have heard much less of their movements than we did before, and their exertions have been confined for the present to the establishment of a more effectual blockade; but we cannot doubt that they have in preparation measures of a more important character. The British squadron, more especially, has now been reinforced by several crews of battle ships—the Royal Albert, the Hannibal, the Algerine, the Princess Royal, and the Jean d'Acre, which greatly augments its sea force; and the progress of this siege, and since the unsuccessful cannonade of the 17th of October, it is to be supposed that the Admirals have in view a plan of attack more effective than that which was frustrated by several different causes on the former occasion.

A few days more, however, will remove our present anxious uncertainty, and we doubt not that the British fleet, as well as the British army, will be found in its right place, by the side of our brave allies, on that great day which may decide the fate of Sebastopol.—London Times.

Arrival of the "Asia."

STORMING OF SEBASTOPOL CONTINUED.

HALF-PAY, May 8.

The steamship Asia arrived about 10 o'clock last night. The steamship Hermann sailed from Southampton for New York. The latest intelligence from the Crimea is to the effect that Lord Raglan, and the 22nd from the Russian Commander.

The bombardment still continues, though without important result. The opening of the French Exhibition has been postponed to the 15th May. Richardson, Spence & Co. report bread-stuffs considerably advanced. Since the breaking up of the Vienna conference there has been four supplementary meetings of the four parties, without result. The Plenipotentiaries reassembled on the 23d, signed the protocol of the conference. Subsequently there was a meeting by the request of Prince Menschikoff, when further inadmissible propositions were made by the Russian Plenipotentiary, which were rejected by France, England, and Turkey.

Baron de Hays's departure is postponed for a few days to discuss matters with the Austrian Government. The general opinion in England is that war must continue for a lengthened period. The London Times speaks of the policy of the new Czar as no longer as usual, is so regarded throughout Europe. Nothing definite is known about the troops. The general impression is favorable to the allies, but the Russians returned their fire in a spirited manner.

Details of the news from the Crimea state that April 14th, the bombardment continued night and day for 500 guns.
