DARK CAKE

One-half cup sugar, four tablespoons melted butter or drippings, one-half cup molasses, one teaspoonful soda in one-half cup sour milk, 2-1/2 cups of flour. Add spice and salt and raisins if liked. Bake slowly in a loaf.

MEAL AND FLOUR CRUST

Take equal parts of graham and fine flour, and wet into a dough with diluted sweet cream.

COOKING NAVY BEANS

A southern cook says a splendid method of cooking navy beans is to parboil them till tender, then drain them of liquid and bake them in the pan with a pork roast. Beans can be baked in one end of the pan and sweet potatoes in the other. Cooked in this manner, both vegetables are rich and tempting.
