9198, ex-Sgt. Hector Claude McCarthy, 84, died May 18, 1979, at Ottawa, Ontario. He was born March 6, 1895, at Toronto and joined the Force as a special constable on September 17, 1914, at Ottawa. On March 1, 1920, McCarthy re-engaged as a regular member, was promoted corporal the same day and posted to HQ Division, where he remained until April 1, 1935, when he was transferred to "A" Division. He was promoted sergeant on August 1, 1934, and on March 31, 1944, transferred from the RCMP to the Department of Finance.

10487, ex-Cst. Henry Langstaff Hunter, 70, died April 16, 1979, at Turtleford, Sask. He was born April 15, 1909, at

Whitby, England, and joined the RCMP on September 8, 1928, at Regina. Following recruit training at Depot, he was posted to Whitehorse Detachment in "B" Division, where he remained until leaving the Force at the end of his term in 1932. On September 27, 1939, Hunter re-joined the Force for a one-year term, serving at St. Walburg, Radisson and North Battleford before he left, time expired on September 27, 1940.

12100, ex-Sgt. Thomas Clayton Mathers, 72, died at White Rock, B.C., on May 26, 1979. Born July 30, 1907, at Grimsby, England, he emigrated to Canada in 1927 and later joined the RCMP on December 5, 1933. His first posting after Depot was North Battleford Detachment, "F" Division; later Regina Town Station, Broadview and Prince Albert Detachments. He was transferred to "E" Division in 1941, and was eventually stationed at Es-
