An Act further to amend the Act respecting the Harbor of Pictou.

[Assented to 25th May, 1883.]

Preamble.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Partial exemption of certain ships from harbor dues. 1. The harbor dues imposed by the Act passed in the thirty-sixth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act respecting the Harbor of Pictou in Nova Scotia," shall not be payable on any ship exceeding forty tons and not exceeding eighty tons register, more than twice in any calendar year, beginning on the first day of January and ending on the thirty-first day of December, whatever may be the number of times she enters the said harbor during the year.

Governor may increase and again decrease the number of Commissioners for the said Harbor. 2. The Governor may, if he sees fit, at any time and from time to time, increase the number of Commissioners for the superintendence of the said harbor and of the harbor master at the port of Pictou, under the said Act, from three to five, and may, at any time and from time to time, reduce their number from five to three; and the five or three Commissioners, for the time being, shall have the powers and duties assigned to Commissioners by the said Act, and the Acts in amendment thereof.

Prosecution for violation of rules.

3. The said Commissioners shall have power to prosecute any person violating any rule or regulation made under the said Act, and the Acts in amendment thereof.
