- Revenue.* Bill for raising a revenue, 971, 975.
- Roads.* Bill further to continue certain Acts providing for the repairing of the streets and bridges in the City and County of Saint John, 956, 961, 963, 964, 968, 980. *Passed.*
 — Bill to continue the several Acts relative to roads and highways, 971, 973, 981. *Passed.*
 — See *Appropriation of the Public Revenue; Fences with Gates.*
- Roman Catholics.* Bill for the relief of His Majesty's Roman Catholic Subjects in this Province, 968, 970, 973, 974, 976, 981. *Passed.* See *Protest.*
- Sackville.* Bill to ascertain all ungranted lands in the township of Sackville, and to vest all the vacant and unlocated wilderness lots within the same in the Crown, 964, 966.
- Saint Andrews.* Bill to grant John Aymar the privilege of supplying it with water by pipes, 949, 951, 957, 960, 963, 980. *Passed.*
- Salt, Measurement of.* See *Carmen.*
- Seamen.* See *Lands for public uses.*
- Sergeant at Arms.* Xenophon Jouett, Esquire, appoints a Deputy who is approved and ordered to attend accordingly, 938.
- Sewers.* Bill to repeal the Acts of 26 G. 3, c. 45, and 34 G. 3, c. 8, relating to Commissioners of Sewers, and to make provisions in lieu thereof, 964, 967, 969, 981. *Passed.*
- Small Debts.* Bill to alter and amend the Act of 50 G. 3, c. 17, for the recovery of small debts, 955, 958, 959, 964, 980. *Passed.*
- Trespasses.* Bill further to continue the Act of 59 G. 3, c. 6, for the punishment of persons guilty of the trespasses therein mentioned, in the City of Saint John, 939, *ib.* 941, 943, 964, 969, 979. *Passed.*
 — Bill to repeal all the Acts relating to trespasses, and to make more effectual provision for the same, 956, 961.
