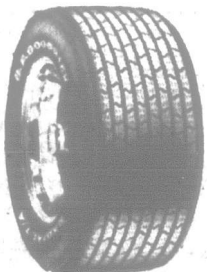

### Passing with outside of foot

Good players do not reveal what they are about to do. Passing with the outside of the foot could mislead many of your opponents.

- Position support foot near ball
- Lock ankle of kicking foot and point toes down and inwards
- Contact ball with outside of kick-

ing foot

• Follow through by flicking ball to desired space or player

This move is often used in a "one-two" or wall pass.

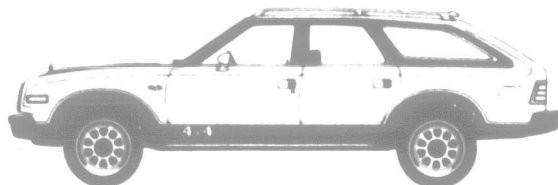

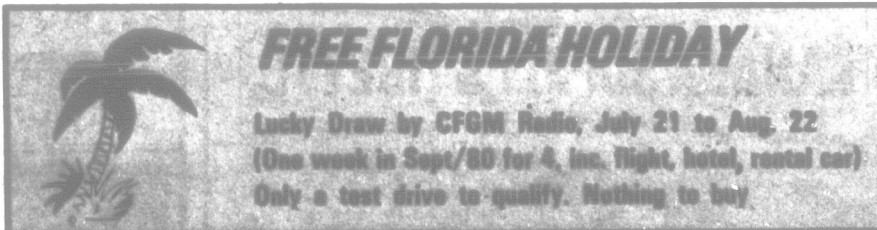
