their mode of plantinely, and the loss of their fish lover, have roidently disheartened threw. The want of food, arising from these causes, has led to their dishersion in order to obtain a livelihood by huntinely. You will observe that these sions are breaking up from jealousies among three. An active Agent, could induce them all to settle ow the Reserve, which is very desirable, in view of the erection of mission Buildings by the Church of Sueland, - as well as of the interference with future settlements which their seathering would produce.
