decided to hold a meeting Thursday afternoon. Feb. 14th, which they did. They decided to ask for 10¢ per hour for men who did not receive an increase, also for the recognition of a department committee. The men returned to work Friday morning but were refused work. Members of the General Works Committee reported to the Manufacturing Superintendent and were told that it was in the hands of the government. When the conciliator came to the city, he met the management and also the members of the committee and he decided to put the men back to work pending an investigation which is going on at the present time.
