

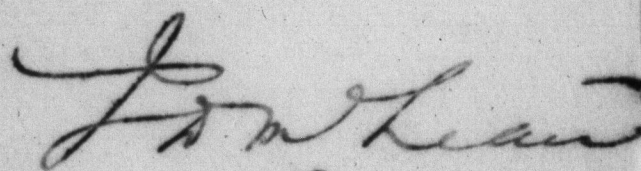
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Ottawa, 22nd December, 1908.

Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 17th instant, in which you state that ~~M~~ Violet Hendrick, who is at present a patient in the Children's Hospital, Toronto, requires a long hip splint, which will cost about \$10.00, and also special boots which will cost about \$7.00, making a total expenditure of \$17.00, I beg to say that they may be purchased. The Department desires to receive a report regarding the child's present condition. It should be stated whether she has improved under treatment, how long she has been in the hospital, and how much longer it is proposed that she shall remain in the Institution, and also what final results are looked for. The matter should be given early attention.
