I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, in regard to your question of the receipt of the duplicate of Lease No. 197, which was issued from the 100,000,000 Reserve and held under the former title of "Lot 120". In view of the fact that the duplicate of the Lease is held by the same person, it is not necessary to issue a new Lease, and, regarding the same, it is requested that you will refer the matter to the attention of the Hon. Minister of the Interior, and if possible to cancel Lease No. 197 without a full representation being made, and may please advise me of the result. Kindly state whether, or not, the same is being observed. Your obedient servant, cancelled, if so, obtain from them a statement in writing to that effect and forward same to the Department, upon receipt of which the question of issue of the new Lease will be given due consideration.
