The accused, No. E-628806, Private Maurice LAMBERT, General List, C.A., attached to A-13 C.I.T.C., C.A., an N.R.M.A. soldier of the Canadian Army placed on Active Service, is charged with:

FIRST CHARGE:

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE, DESERTING HIS MAJESTY'S SERVICE,

in that he

at Valcartier Camp, P.Q., at 0700 hours, on the 9th of January 1945, after having been warned for proceeding on special duty, with intent to avoid so proceeding, absented himself without leave from A-13 C.I.T.C., C.A., until he surrendered himself to Military Authorities at Quebec, P.Q. on the 13th day of March 1945, at 1515 hours, wearing military uniform.

SECOND CHARGE:

LOSING BY NEGLIGENCE HIS EQUIPMENT, CLOTHING AND NECESSARIES,

in that he

at Valcartier Camp, P.Q., on the 17th of March 1945, was deficient of the following articles, viz:
