respectively contained, shall be, and the same are hereby continued, and shall remain in force for Ten Years from the passing hereof, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly, and no longer.

CAP. III.

An ACT further to continue an Act relating to Landlord and Tenant.

[February 11, 1852.]

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act passed in the Sixth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, Queen Victoria, intituled An Act relating to Landlord and Tenant, and which was Ten Years Act continued by an Act passed in the Ninth year 6 Via. cap. 20. of the said Reign, intituled An Act to continue an Act relating to Landlord and Tenant, be, and the same is hereby further continued and declared to be in force for Ten Years from the passing hereof, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly, and no longer.

CAP. IV.

An ACT further to continue an Act regulating Seamen shipped on board of any Ship or Vessel belonging to Prince Edward Island, whilst within the Precincts of the said Island.

[February 11, 1852.]

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act passed Continues for
