LAND REGULATIONS. THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a puarter section of available Dominion land a Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Apolicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for he District. Entry by proxy may be made it any Dominion Lands Agency (but not ub-Agency), on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and ultivation of the land in each of three cars. A homesteader may live within time miles of his homestead on a farm of it least 80 acres, on certain conditions.
