The abolition applies to all luxury taxes adopted in the last budget except those on spirituous and atcoholic liquors, medicated wines, patent and proprietory preparations, playing cards and confectionery. All luxury taxes, except those mentioned, are abolished whether paid by merchants, manufacturers or importers.
