

MARKET TALK!

There was a broad and active market on the New York Exchange last week accompanied by wide price movements. The holder of 100 Standard who bought on all dips and sold one or two points up, could have netted around \$300. Philip Morris (tobacco) ran up to \$11 from a low of \$8.50 and a low in April of \$4.12. Radio declined from \$4.75 to \$3.50 and recovered to \$4.25. Middle States from \$12.12 went to \$13.62. Simms dropped off from \$11.50 to \$9.37 and subsequently up to \$10.75. Plak, Eastern, Pacific, Bledge and U. S. Continentals were fairly firm and stationary. It looks as if the usual February dullness will merge into another market advance. This is buying time, especially on recessions.


