Lynden.—How long has B to be a resident of a municipality before he is liable for poll tax? Ans.—There is no limit as to time. He is liable to pay where he now resides unless he produces a certificate of having paid poll tax for the current year to a ne other municipality in Ontario.

Fence.-A divided a line fence and put Fence.—A divided a line fence and put a good capped wire fence on his half. B put a slack, slimpsy one. To whom must A apply? Can trees grow over on A and encumber his ground? To whom can A go for redress? What is a lawful fine? Ans.—An award of the fence-viewers of the township must be obtained by A to compel B to properly ferce his half of the line fence. 
