LONDON, Dec. 17.—Mr. Parrell addressed a large meeting at Nottingham this afternoon. He declared there were many who were not in favor of the Home Rule movement, but he said that the Home Rule movement was a movement of such magnitude for the country which was so comparatively free from crime as the Land League movement. The object of the Home Rule movement, he said, was to regenerate Ireland, especially with regard to her industrial condition.
