BROOKE COUNCIL

Council met pursuant to adjournment. Members all present. Minutes of former meeting read.

Johnston—Wallis that engineer be requested if he deemed expedient to do so change the course of the Wenden—McKeller drain, as provided under Section 77 of the "Municipal Drainage Act," with power to vary the assessment. Changes made and minutes adopted.

Communications received from Clerk of Warwick re repairing the McGill drain without report of engineer, if ratepayers are willing.

Holbrook—Loosemore—that clerk notify Warwick township that Brooke township will not be responsible for any damages caused by the drain not put in a proper state of repair.—Carried.

Petition received signed by a majority in numbers, asking that the area composed of the S W ¼, lot 19 and S E ¼, 19 and S ¼ lot 20, in concession seven, be drained by means of a drain or drains.

Wallis—Johnston—that petition be entertained and Geo. A. McCubbin, O. L. S., be requested to make an examination of the area to be drained; make a survey and submit a report, plan, profile and estimate, and to make an assessment of all lands and roads liable for assessment under the provisions of "The Municipal Drainage Act."—Carried.

Petition received sufficiently signed both as to numbers and assessments, requesting that a cement walk 3½ feet in width be constructed on the south side of Atkinson St., Inwood, commencing at the intersection of the walk on the west side of Park St. and extending to the west limits of lot no. 1 and that payments to be extended over a period of five years.

Loosemore—Holbrook—that petition be entertained and A. S. Code, O. L. S., be requested to lay out walk, make estimate of costs, the same to be assessed against lots and streets benefited and report to Council.—Carried.

Wallis—Johnston—that Clerk get itemized account from Dr. McLean of his expenses to Toronto convention.—Carried.

Granted on motion of Johnston and Loosemore.

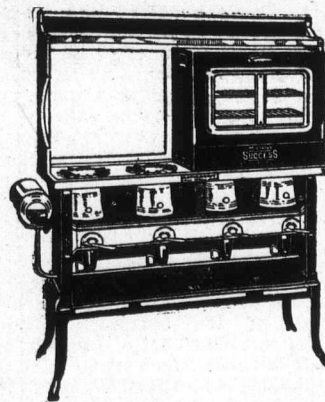
