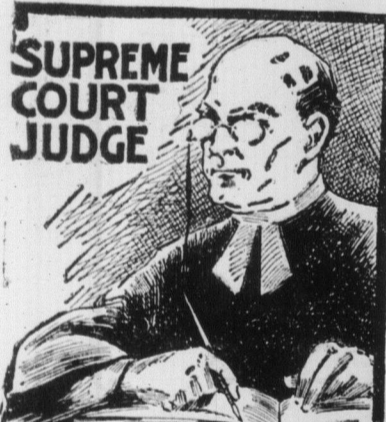

Dominion Atlantic Educational Film Bureau for Annapolis Valley

Mr. George E. Graham, General Manager of the Dominion Atlantic Railway, has established a film bureau in connection with the railway.

Plans are now perfected for the distribution of these films throughout the entire country contiguous to the Dominion Atlantic.

Many universities of the United States are now using motion pictures to supplement lectures, and in conducting their extension courses. The pictures issued by the Dominion Atlantic are of a character intended to supplement the valuable work being conducted by the Agricultural College at Truro, and the Dominion Experimental Station at Kentville.

It is contemplated that these picture campaigns will create among the young people of the Annapolis Valley an even greater interest in these important institutions.

The films now ready include the following subjects:

1. Killing and Dressing Poultry
2. The Strawberry.
3. Raspberry Culture.
4. Parts of a Bee Hive
5. The Wintering of Bees.
6. Conformation of a Holstein Dairy Cow
7. The Handling of Bees
8. Rearing Chickens.
9. Box Packing of Apples.
10. Potatoes for Profit
11. The Community Canning Centre
12. Re-Foresting Part 1
13. Re-Foresting Part 2.
14. Rearing Chickens.
15. Paper and Pulp.
16. The Manufacture of Cheese in Holland.

These films will be displayed in country schools and churches, and

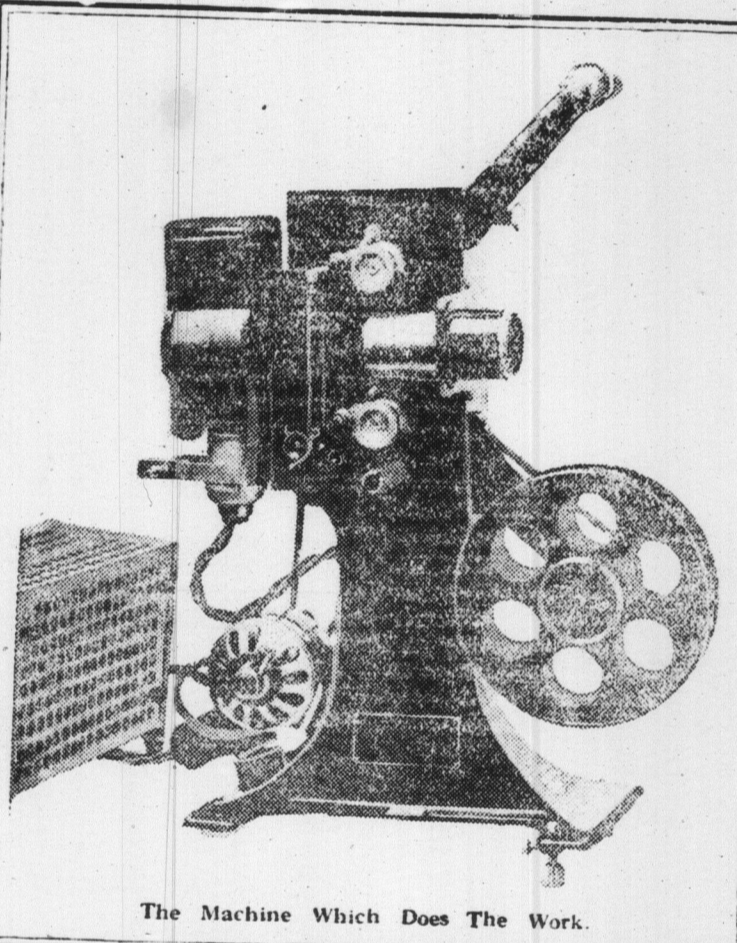
are available for Boards of Trade, Commercial Clubs, Farmers Conventions, Women's Institutes, Fruit Growers and Agricultural Society meetings. In country districts where such institutions do not exist, the men and women may appoint committees to arrange for a weekly programme.

Where school buildings cannot be used, the projecting machines may be set up and operated in any fair-sized room. When local electric current is not to be had, storage batteries are used. The complete operating outfit and films are supplied by the railway without cost. In co-operation with the Dominion Atlantic, Local and Federal Agricultural Officials supply a lecture service covering the subjects pictured.

Additional subjects will be added as requirements are indicated and will for the most part be made on the farms of the country.

The company have a supply of films amusing and entertaining in character, one or more of which may be introduced in the course of an evening of utility film.

Four or five films require an hour to display. This number together with talks upon the subjects illustrated make up a profitable evening's entertainment of not too great length.
