*Voted*, to appoint a Committee to report on the expediency of renewing the petition to the Legislature, for an Act of Incorporation for the Grand and Subordinate Divisions of the Order in this Province.

Bros. Hon. J. W. Johnston, John Campbell, W. M. Brown, C. B. Naylor, and Robert Noble, were appointed in accordance with the foregoing vote.

On motion, *voted*, to reconsider the vote, affirming the ineligibility of Bros. William Burrill, A. M. Gidney, and Thos. O. Geddes, to re-election as representatives to the National Division.

The following resolutions were moved by Bro. P. G. W. P., J. McMurray:—

*Resolved*, That it is to be regretted that the credentials of the following brothers, viz.: William Burrill, Thos. O. Geddes and Angus M. Gidney, have not been presented to this Grand Division, to enable them to have been elected as representatives to the National Division.

*And whereas*, we believe it to have been an oversight of the Divisions to which they belong, in not attending to this duty.

*Therefore resolved*, That we now proceed to the election of said brothers, and if elected, and they produce their credentials to the satisfaction of the G. W. P. in two months from this time, they shall be considered as representatives to the National Division, otherwise their election will be considered void.
