University-to-university agreement which was first established in 1982 and has been renewed in 1992. The exchange program is designed for up to two students or faculty members. Last year, two students from either university participated in the program. Applicants are expected to have second year standing ("Vordiplom" or "Zwischenprüfung"). German students should also submit a short description of their aims at the partner university in English and achieve a certain score in the TOEFL Test. Participants are selected by the "Akademisches Auslandsamt" in Siegen and the Student Exchange Programs Coordinator at Dalhousie. The program covers a tuition waiver and Canadian students may either apply for a "DAAD-Kontaktstipendium" which includes a financial grant of DM 900 per month or they may receive a supportive grant from the "Ministerium für Wissenschaft und Forschung des Landes Nordrhein- Westfalen", the provincial ministry for science and research. Canadian students may also take part in special cultural and recreational events for exchange students. The exchange lasts one academic year and students remain enrolled at their home university. German students receive special leave status.
