Mr. Forgie, from the Standing Committee on Veterans Affairs, presented the Second Report of the said Committee, which was read as follows:

Your Committee recommends that it be granted leave to sit while the House is sitting.

By unanimous consent, on motion of Mr. Forgie, seconded by Mr. Habel, the said Report was concurred in.

Mr. Batten, from the Standing Committee on Debates, presented the First Report of the said Committee, which was read as follows:

Your Committee recommends:

2. That it be authorized to sit while the House is sitting.
