Mr. Speaker: I declare the motion lost. At this point the Chair is in the hands of the House. Shall we proceed to Question Period?

Mr. Pinard: First of all, Mr. Speaker, you were seeking unanimous consent to put the main motion. We certainly do not object on this side. I received this request from the House Leader of the Official Opposition earlier and I told him that certainly we would agree to a 45-minute Question Period provided he understands that if some Ministers had previous commitments they would be free to leave.

Mr. Nielsen: That is accurate, Mr. Speaker. We would have no objection to dealing with the main motion now on the condition, as I interpret the remarks of the Government House Leader, that we could have 45 minutes. We clearly understand there may be commitments which have to be made.

Mr. Deans: Mr. Speaker, I want to be clear on exactly what we are agreeing to. If the main motion is put now, there will be a further division. Does that mean that we will then, at the end of the division, have 45 minutes for Question Period?
