consecutive times may be declared by the House Committee to have resigned, and the President of the Club shall be called upon to fill the existing vacancy for the unexpired term of such resigned member.

## Article IV.

COMPLAINTS.

SEC. I. Complaints of any matter by members must be made in writing and addressed and delivered to some member of the House Committee, who shall lay the same before said Committee at its next meeting.

## Article V.

VISITORS

SEC. 1. Members may introduce non-resident visitors to the Club, for its privileges for two weeks, and resident visitors not oftener than once a month. A Register will be kept for the purpose of recording names of visitors and the introducing member; and the latter will be held personally responsible for the good conduct and standing of such visitor.

## Article VI.

NOTICES.

SEC. 1. All notices may be served either personally, by mail, or by leaving at the residence or place of business of the member for whom the same may be intended.

Sec. 2. The address given by such member on joining the Club shall be deemed such place of business or residence until written notice is given
