| The heirs of James Boyd. | Two thousand acres. | He lost 50,000 acres of land, on which were some valuable improvements on the <i>East</i> side of what is <i>now</i> known to be the river St. Croix. |
| Martha Walker, widow of Thomas Walker. | Two thousand acres. | His services, sacrifices and sufferings appear to have been equal to any of those of the Refugees. He lost property to the amount of <i>l.</i> 2,500 <i>st.</i> beside abandoning a lucrative business. |
| John Edgar. | Two thousand acres. | He rendered many important services. His losses were very great and his sufferings still greater. |
| Seth Harding. | Two thousand acres. | The Commissi. have heretofore reported on this case. |
