Sailing from and arriving at all Ports, except between the hours of sunset and sunrise, all Officers will wear frock coats and brown gloves, or all Officers will wear greatcoats, according to the instructions of the Commander. White cap covers will be worn from May 1st to September 30th inclusive.

COMMANDER.—Blue cloth, double-breasted, same cut, standard of length and number of buttons, Company's pattern, as Navy frock coat, cuffs trimmed with four rows gold lace ½ inch in width, two centre rows forming a cross diamond.

CHIEF OFFICER.—The same, but cuffs trimmed with three rows gold lace, two top rows forming a cross diamond.

First Officer.—The same, but cuffs trimmed with two rows gold lace, forming a cross diamond in centre.
