An Act to amend the several Acts relating to the Board of Trade of the City of Toronto.

W HEREAS the Board of Trade of the City of Toronto, Preamble hereinafter called the Board of Trade, incorporated by an Act of the Legislature of the late Province of Canada, passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's reign, chaptered 5 twenty-four, and intituled: "An Act to incorporate the ⁸ V., c. ²⁴ Board of Trade of the City of Toronto," have petitioned for ^(''an.) certain amendments to the said Act, and to the Act passed in the forty-seventh year of Her Majesty's reign, chaptered forty-six, and intituled : "An Act to amalgamate the Board 47 V., c 46.

10 of Trade of the City of Toronto and the Toronto Corn Exchange Association," and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :-
