An Act to repeal The Conservation Act and Amendments.

1909, c. 27; 1910, c. 42; 1913, c. 12. HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Repeal.

1. The Conservation Act, chapter twenty-seven of the statutes of 1909, and all amendments thereto, are hereby 5 repealed.

Provision for carrying on Commission's work. 2. The Governor in Council may, notwithstanding anything in *The Civil Service Act*, 1918, or any other statute, make such orders and regulations as he may deem necessary or advisable for the carrying on and completion of the work 10 of The Commission of Conservation by other departments of the Government and for the absorption by such other departments of such officers, clerks and employees of the Commission as they may respectively require.
