

Regulations
FOR THE
Quebec Central Schools
FOR BOYS AND GIRLS,
Conducted upon the Madras System.

1. Rules for the information of the Public.

1. The general regulation of the Schools shall be in strict conformity with the Instructions of Dr. Bell, except where a deviation may become necessary from local circumstances.
2. The children of Roman Catholic Parents, and of those who are Members of the national Church of Scotland will be allowed to attend their respective places of worship on Sundays, instead of going, with the other children, to the English Cathedral—and the former (and if the Parents should desire it, the latter also,) will be exempted from learning the Catechism of the Church of England.
3. Such Parents as can afford to contribute towards the education of their children, but cannot conveniently pay the usual rate of Schooling will be allowed to send them to the Central Schools at the rate of ten or five shillings per quarter, according to their circumstances—and these children will be exempted from the duties performed in rotation by the Scholars of sweeping, sawing, splitting wood &c.—The Money thus raised will be applied in defraying the current expences of the Schools.
