A Few Hints.... To Mining Investors.

To the average thoughtful and conservative investor mining is looked upon as an exceedingly hazardous venture, one almost sure to prove disastrous and embodying almost every known objectionable feature in the market of investment.

The market value of this claim as it lies is not much over \$100, so we will assume it to be needed to a purchaser at that figure. Now what is done? A company is formed with one million dollars capital, of which three or four hundred thousand shares are deemed.

While there is no question but British Columbia is destined to be one of the greatest mining camps on earth, and thereby of incalculable value to this country, it can readily be seen that we cannot afford to pay \$100,000 to develop every \$1000 claim. One who goes into a plan of this kind is not speculating, for "speculation" implies a possibility of profit as well as loss, and his chance of gain is about parallel to that of drawing the capital prize in the Louisiana lottery.
