**SYRIANS BRUTALLY BEATEN.**  
Boat Hands of the Steamer Midland, Alleged to Have Used Two Men Most Shamefully.

**EIGHT MEN HAD A HAND IN IT**  
According to the Information at Hand—Civilians Are Looking After the Victims.

The Owen Sound Sun tells a story of brutal treatment of two Syrians by the boat hands of the steamer Midland last Tuesday night. According to the Sun's informant, the two men, who are between 20 and 40 years of age, took passage on the Midland for Algoma Mills. Each man had a large trunk, and during the night they took turns at sleeping by stretching their bodies on the trunks in the hold of the vessel. Towards morning, some of the boat hands, who are alleged to have been somewhat under the influence of liquor, pulled one of the Syrians off his cot and demanded to know if he had anything good to drink in the way of liquor. One of them replied that there was lots of water on board, and at once led the way to a nearby tap. The Syrian took umbrage at this, and accused the Syrians of being d—d Boers. This was emphatically denied, one of the men exhibiting a Lord Roberts' button on the lapel of his coat. He was then struck on the head and severely beaten about the body. Some eight boat hands are alleged to have joined in the assault, and one of the Syrians was robbed of a gold watch and chain. They finally ran out on the deck, and, after an ineffectual appeal to the others, took refuge in one of the staterooms, but the Midland pulling out without them, their trunks were still on board.

The men, who give their names as Charles Joseph and John Essey, have boat tickets for Algoma Mills and checks for their trunks. Wednesday morning they were found wandering about the streets, one of them minus his hat, and both feeling very sore and ill from the brutal treatment they had been subjected to. They were also without money. Aid. Miller, chairman of the Market and Police Committee, interested himself in the case at once, and took steps to have the men cared for until the receipt of the Midland, when the charges will be thruply investigated. It is also understood that Chief McAulley has been hunting up evidence as to the truth of the statements made by the Syrians, and has no reason to question their veracity. The Midland will return some time Sunday evening. At the present time the Syrians are being lodged at the Comely House by order of Acting Mayor Reed.

Yesterday the men were very ill, and were examined by Dr. Hervey, who will give evidence at the investigation as to the nature and extent of the injuries sustained.

**CAUGHT BY THE MANAGER.**

**HAMILTON MAN DROWNED.**  
DIED OF BRIGHT'S DISEASE.

Verdict in the Case of Mrs. Canary, Who Was Beaten by Her Husband

AND DIED IN THE CITY HOSPITAL.

Doctors Admitted That Possibly Death Was Hastened by the Beating—General News.

Hamilton, July 20.—(Special.)—The official responsible for the administration of law in this county are criticised in many circles in connection with the death of Mrs. James Canary, South Ferguson-avenue, who died at the General Hospital on Wednesday night. The inquest was continued to-day. No. 2 Police Station.

The Crown Attorney was not present, and there was no person present to act for him. The post-mortem examination was made by Dr. Glasco, who attended the woman prior to her removal to the hospital, and by Dr. Edger, who gave a certificate yesterday that death was due to Bright's disease. Their report of the post-mortem examination supported their statement in the certificate, to be sure. The department had no witnesses present, and no ante-mortem statement had been taken for the reason, the Police Chief says, that it was not known by them that Mrs. Canary was in a critical condition.

Dr. Glasco's testimony was to the effect that he attended Mrs. Canary for Bright's disease some time before her death. On July 10 he found her very weak, and he advised her to go to the hospital. Her husband, and ordered her to the hospital. Both her eyes were blackened, and her face and body were bruised. In reply to a question, he said the shock from her beating she received might have tended to hasten her death, but he did not think so. He reported that Bright's disease caused death.

"How long had she had the disease?" asked the Coroner.  
"I don't know," replied the doctor.  
"What she formerly a patient of yours?"  
Coroner Griffin ironically said he did not know that she was, but if she was, she did not die under his care.

Dr. Edger, superintendent of the City Hospital, said he was assisted by Dr. Glasco in making the post-mortem examination at Green Bros' establishment, and he also expressed the opinion that death was due to Bright's disease. He admitted, however, that death may have been hastened by the shock from the beating.

**The Police Testimony.**  
P. C. Sayers was removed Mrs. Canary to her home to the hospital. She was very weak, and was badly bruised, and showed him marks. She asked him to tell her husband she was going to the hospital. With difficulty he awoke Canary from a drunken stupor, and gave him the message. Canary's reply was: "Tell her to go to hell."

**What Canary Says.**  
Canary, who has been under arrest since her removal to the hospital, said she seemed to be dazed. He said he did not remember being hit.

The verdict was: "We find that Ann Canary's death was due to Bright's disease, and that this disease was found on her body were induced by her husband."
