FINANCIAL.

During the year 1893 the total expenditure of the Works Department (not in-
cluding Water Works) was \$1,307,409.92, divided as follows :

General appropriation.....	\$351,146 57
Local improvements.....	186,386 73
Special services.....	377,846 45
Street railway pavements.....	392,030 17

\$1,307,409 92

The amount for local improvements was divided as follows :

Sewers.....	\$9,899 32
Pavements.....	102,316 50
Sidewalks.....	43,127 17
Grading, bridges, etc.....	31,043 74

Total..... \$186,386 73

The number of petitions received by the Department for local improvement
works during the year was 58. The number of local improvements recommended was
56, made up as follows :

Sewers.....	13
Roadways.....	54
Sidewalks.....	198
Street extensions.....	1

Of the sidewalks recommended, 2 were for concrete, and the remainder for wood.
